## Reports available on count day

During the data entry phase of the computer count, a hard copy report detailing progressive first preference results for each candidate will be made available to scrutineers.

The *First Preference Votes Counted* report (Example A, page 5) will be generated and displayed at the intervals shown below.

Estimated count duration	Less than 1 hour	1 to 3 hours	Longer than 3 hours
Timing of report generation	Generated at end of count only	Generated at 1.5 hours and end of count	Generated at 1.5 hours, then every 3 hours of data entry (at a minimum).

Following the conclusion of the data entry phase and the calculation of the result, a final version of this report will be printed, along with a report detailing all distributions of preferences. Both will be made available to candidates and scrutineers and any other interested parties.

There are two types of distribution reports for computer counts:

- 1. The *Distribution of Preference Votes* report (Example C, page 8) which will only be generated once the final results have been calculated for single-vacancy elections.
- 2. The *Proportional Representation Distribution* report (Example D, page 9) which will only be generated once the final results have been calculated for multi-vacancy elections

## Reports available after count day by request

The *Ballot Paper Details* report (Example B, pages 6 and 7) will only be generated on count day for use during any quality assurance procedures or when the audit of a batch is required.

A full version of this report (soft copy) will be available from the Election Manager, by request, within two days of the Declaration occurring.

Note that once election material has been sealed and stored in accordance with legislation, this data will no longer be available.
