

# Frankston City Council Extraordinary Vacancy

---



An extraordinary vacancy has occurred in North-West Ward on Frankston City Council due to the resignation of Councillor Steven Hughes on Monday 11 December 2023.

The vacancy will be filled through a countback of the formal ballot papers cast at the last general election in October 2020. Votes will be redistributed to candidates who were unsuccessful at that general election, and who remain eligible to participate in the countback, to fill the extraordinary vacancy.

The countback will take place at **10 am on Monday 15 January 2024**.

The Victorian Electoral Commission will be hosting the countback online via webinar from 9.30 am on Monday 15 January 2024. Interested parties may observe the countback by visiting [vec.vic.gov.au](http://vec.vic.gov.au)
