Election day is Saturday 8 February. There are several ways you can vote.

## ? Why is Prahran District having a by-election?

A by-election is being held in Prahran District on Saturday 8 February to elect a new member of Parliament, after the resignation of Sam Hibbins on Saturday 23 November 2024.

## Vote early

### Early voting is open from Wednesday 29 January to Friday 7 February.

You don't need a reason to vote early. You can find information on opening hours and locations in our Election Venue Locator.

Election day is Saturday 8 February. You can vote at any voting centre in Prahran District from 8 am to 6 pm.

## Voting by post

You can apply for a postal vote from now until 6 pm on Wednesday 5 February. You can apply online or pick up a paper form at the election office at:

For your vote to count, you must post it back to us or drop it off at any voting centre before 6 pm on Saturday 8 February.

You can vote by phone if you:

- are blind or have low vision
- have a physical disability and can't vote without assistance.

If you missed that date, you can complete a provisional vote. Bring proof of your address (like a rates notice or electricity bill in your name) to the voting centre and enrol and vote on the spot.
